On Tuesday, the Cornwallis site received a visit from our Trust's CEO, Mr. James Higham, who observed the children undertaking either their History or PE learning. As we entered the Year 6 classrooms all the children were wearing their own luggage tags and were learning about some people's perceptions of the evacuees during WWII. (My own father was one of those evacuees who was sent down to North Devon, which remained one of his favourite places.)

On Wednesday the Year 2 children joined other schools at Rugby High School for a cricket festival. I have it on good authority that we have a number of extremely good bowlers in the making.
