#### Parents' Workshop - SEND - Open to all




If you have ever found it difficult to understand the different levels of special educational needs in schools and what this means, please come to the SEND workshop with Mrs Howard (SENDCO). We will look at how learning is supported and monitored within schools, what SEN monitoring, SEN supported and Education, Health and Care Plans mean for children. There will be an opportunity to ask generalised questions during the session and to request an individual appointment at a later date.
