



School Clubs Spring 2 2026

Some of our clubs are run by school staff and have a cost in order to cover the cost of resources. School staff that run clubs do not get paid to do so which helps to minimise the cost to parents. Children who receive Pupil Premium Funding can access 2 clubs per half term for free (with the exception of STKD Tae Kwon Do).

Children attending after school clubs must be collected on time. Please do not use the school car park when collecting your child from a club. In order to ensure the children's safety, we would ask that parents wait outside the main school entrance (automatic sliding doors) when collecting from an after-school club.

Refunds will only be given in **exceptional circumstances** as places cannot be reoffered once a club has commenced.

Clubs will commence week beginning Monday 23rd February and run for 5 weeks.

Multi Sports Club

This club will be run by a coach from Harris School Sports Partnership after school on a Monday from 3.15pm until 4.15pm. The cost is £3.00 per session and there are 16 spaces available open to all year groups. The children will take part in a different sport activity each week in the school hall such as athletics, dodgeball, hockey and mini-tennis.

Craft Club

This club will be run by Mrs Thorns after school on a Monday from 3.15pm until 4.00pm. The cost of the club is £3.00 per session and is open to all year groups with 12 places available. The children will be doing a variety of arts and crafts and getting creative!



Storytelling and Book Club


This club will be run by Miss Bale after school on a Tuesday from 3.15pm until 4.00pm. The cost of the club is £3.00 per session and is open to all year groups with 12 places available. This club is for young readers to come together to explore the magic of stories. Through read-aloud sessions, imaginative discussions, and creative activities, children are encouraged to develop a love for books while building listening, reading, and communication skills.

Please note – there will not be a session on 3rd March due to Parent's Evening.

Target Games Club

The club will be run by a coach from Harris School Sports Partnership after school on a Tuesday from 3.15pm until 4.15pm. The cost is £3.00 per session and there are 16 spaces available, open to all year groups. Target games are activities where children throw an object towards a target to score points. They can help children develop physical and cognitive skills. Activities will include boccia, new age kurling, tri golf, disc golf and archery.

Please note – there will not be a session on 24th March due to coach availability.



Tae Kwon Do Club

This club is run by a coach from STKD after school on a Wednesday from 3.15pm until 4.15pm and is open to all year groups. The cost is £3.00 per session. The children will learn different moves and techniques every week and learn to challenge themselves. They will have the opportunity to reach a new grade (coloured belt) every term at an additional cost of £35 therefore a commitment to the club is expected.
