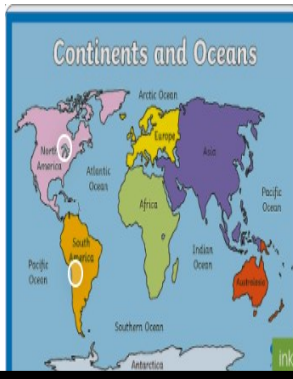
Books to read linked to our topic and writing genres:
