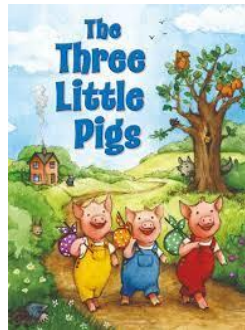
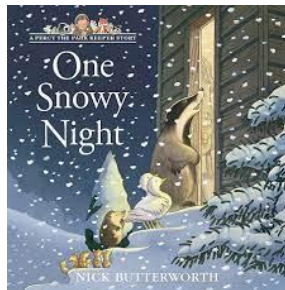

Top facts: What I should know...

Houses can be built from a number of different materials, but some materials are better to use than others because they keep out wind and rain well. Houses are described as 'terraced', 'semi-detached' or 'detached' depending on whether they are joined with houses on both sides, on only one side or aren't joined at all. Materials can be natural or man-made. Natural materials include rock and wood. Man-made materials include glass and plastic.
