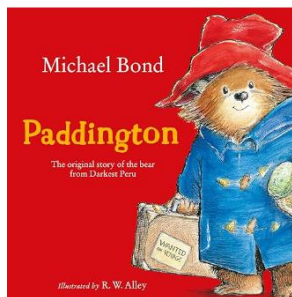

UK stands for United Kingdom. The UK is made up of 4 countries: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Island. King Charles is the King of the United Kingdom. His mother was Queen Elizabeth II. He became King on 8th September 2022. Charles III has two children called William and Harry. Climate means the general weather conditions in an area. Different countries have different climates.

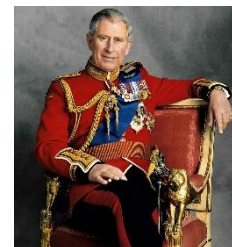
