### **Updated Covid Guidance**

Clarification on the new guidance for isolation:

For individuals with positive LFT results:

- Adults self-isolate for 5 clear days (minimum) after the day of test – which is day 0. Can then return to normal activities only if well enough and don't have a temperature.
- Children self-isolate for 3 clear days (minimum) after the day of test – which is day 0. Can then return to normal activities only if well enough and don't have a temperature.
- If de-isolating before the end of 10 days, avoid contact with vulnerable individuals.
