Danger

We were made aware that cars are continuing to park up on pavements especially on the corner of Grenville Close. This nearly resulted in a child from HHJS being knocked down this week as a car mounted the pavement as he rode down on his scooter. Can I politely remind you that it is an offence to park in a dangerous manner? If you do see a car parked dangerously or inconsiderately please do report it as follows:

If the vehicle is parked:

- on zig zag lines
- dangerously
- in a way that would prevent emergency vehicles from accessing

You can report these to Warwickshire Police online:

If the vehicle is parked:

- over a dropped kerb
- on a pedestrian crossing (including the area marked by the zig-zag lines)
- in spaces reserved for Blue Badge holders, residents or motorbikes (unless entitled to do so)
- in marked taxi bays, cycle lanes or red lines
- near a school entrance, bus or tram stop
- anywhere that would prevent access for Emergency Services


Disco
